❖ The registration fee for each student is \$330.00 (early registration - \$300.00). This fee can be paid in one lump sum at registration or in two semester installments (\$165.00 at registration and \$165.00 in January).

REGISTRATION PREREQUISITES:

1. **ALL TUITION/FEES FROM THE 2009-2010 SCHOOL YEAR MUST BE PAID BEFORE YOU CAN REGISTER FOR THIS SCHOOL YEAR.** Financial hardships are to be discussed with the SCHOOL BOARD ***before*** registration night (the last board meeting before registration night is July 26, 2010).
2. Any family that requests financial assistance for the upcoming school year will be directed to Private School Aid Service (PSAS). PSAS will help us determine the amount of assistance each family needs. If you have any questions, please call Mr. Rodgers.
The DEADLINE is August 15th.
3. Please bring your completed statement of fees with you on registration night and the line will go much faster. (Additional copies are available on the website.)
4. Besides registration tables, there will be tables for each of the groups/activities (Hot Lunch, Extended Care, Athletics, Scouts, Art Outreach, etc.) so please be sure to visit each table. A separate check will be needed for most things, so please come prepared.

SPORTS SIGN UP

All students (grades 5-8) that are planning on participating in a sports program at Trinity are required to fill out a sport participation sheet. These forms will be available at the Athletic Committee Table on Registration Night. The sports fees, \$15.00 per student/sport with a maximum fee of \$30 per student, may be paid at that time.

BANK DRAFT AUTHORIZATION FORM

Included in the "Summer Mailing" section on the website is an authorization form for direct payment to Trinity for your TUITION payments. The Bank Draft arrangement begins with the September tuition payment. If you will be requesting Bank Draft, please bring the Authorization form to registration night, however, also be prepared to pay the August tuition payment by cash or check that night. If you would like the direct deposit to start in August, the form must be submitted to the school office by July 1st. For those on the 12-month payment plan, you will need to bring or mail your payment for the months of June and July to the school office. Should you need assistance calculating your monthly tuition payment, please contact the school office.
