Religious Instructions At Trinity, we teach in a Christ-centered environment. Our faith is developed on a daily basis with class instruction and worship opportunities.

Achievement Testing: Each year the students at Trinity are tested using the Stanford Achievement Test. Our students perform at a high level on our achievement tests. Last year 85% of our student body scored at or above the national average (50%).

Accreditation: Trinity Lutheran School is an accredited school. We have national accreditation with National Lutheran School Accreditation. The accreditation is recognized by North Central Accreditation.

Extracurricular Activities: Trinity Lutheran School works on developing the gifts and talents of each student. With this, Trinity offers choir (at all levels), band programs, individual instrumental instruction, an athletic program (grades 5-8) that includes Volleyball, Basketball, Track, and Cheerleading. Trinity also has a Scholastic Bowl team as well as students who participate in the Illinois Music Education Association.

Registration Fees: \$ 160.00 per semester (members and community).
(Fee does not include religion book, assignment book, or physical education uniforms)

Cost to Educate - \$4,600 per child

Tuition: Community -\$3,400.00 first child **Member**— \$1,200.00 first child

Enrollment Process

1. Complete an Enrollment Form.
2. Submit Form and a \$50.00 deposit on your Fall Registration Fee. Completed Enrollment Forms will be submitted to the Board of Christian Day School. (Board meetings are scheduled for the last Monday of each month.)
3. Schedule a meeting with the school principal.
4. Schedule Medical and Dental Exams. These exams need to be completed before the end of September.
5. Acceptance letters will be mailed as soon as students are accepted.

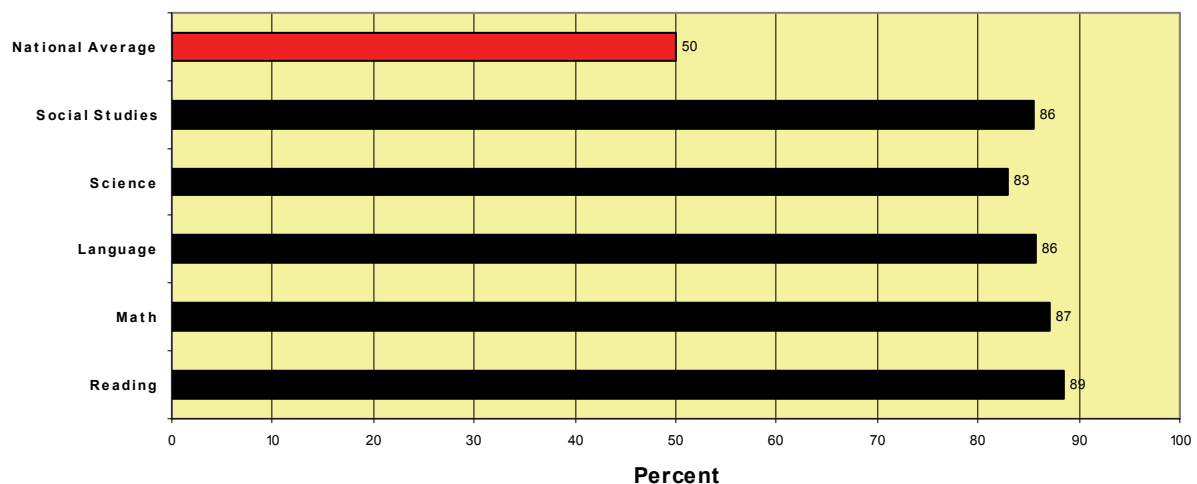
Does Trinity offer a before/after care program? Trinity offers an Extended Care program on days that school is in session.
